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DeLille Cellars 2009 Chaleur Estate Blanc

This year's Chaleur Estate Blanc reflects the warmth and size of the 2009 vintage. A rich and expressive wine featuring a complex nose of dried apricots, figs, grapefruit, flint, toasted straw and grilled bread.

The mouthfeel is rich, silky and voluminous with notes of grapefruit, gooseberries, hazelnuts and toast on the finish.

Although tasting great now, this vintage will develop even more character with short to mid-term cellaring.
