There is also a beautiful floral component and pencil snap notes in the bouquet. The flavors combine cassis, blueberries, huckleberries, black cherries and pepper.

This wine also has beautifully integrated vanilla oak tones and a superb finish, making this a “classic” Chaleur Estate.
