DeLille Cellars 2001 Harrison Hill

As per the '01 vintage, this year's Harrison Hill is riper, darker and more concentrated than usual. There still are the wonderful layers of leather, black cherries and fresh herbs.

However, there are more black fruits and currants present. The oak is totally integrated, showing only whispers of oak spices and cigar box nuances. Lots of Cabernet grip here. This wine is a keeper.
