DeLille Cellars 2007 Harrison Hill

This year's Harrison Hill is a bigger and darker version, while retaining the classic Harrison Hill characters of old-vine Cabernet Sauvignon and its unique terroir.

The nose features a bewitching combination of Bing cherries, plums, lead pencil, violets, and wild herbs. On the palate this wine surprised us with its density and power, yet retained the elegance and long, silky finish that are so characteristic for Harrison Hill.

Definitely one for the cellar; or put a young bottle in the decanter for an hour before enjoying.
