**Doyenne 2007 Métier**

Blending the 2007 Métier Rouge was a real discovery. This because for the first time the Mourvèdre grape came to the fore, lending its untamable personality to the nose of raspberry confit, cherries, strawberry leaf, rhubarb and coriander.

The palate, too, has a richer, more rustic mouth feel due to this blend, highlighted by sweet raspberry and plum fruits, road tar, loam, and a note of allspice. This wine is truly deep and complex; with a long finish and a long life ahead of it that shows us definitively what the Mourvèdre grape can do on Red Mountain. We hope you enjoy this wine as much as we do, which is a departure from previous vintages of this wine.
