Doyenne 2008 Rosé

We are very excited about our 2008 Doyenne Rosé, our first release of this wine. This wine is made in the style of the great Mourvèdre based rosés from the Provence/Bandol region of France.

Don't be fooled by the pale salmon color, this is a complete and complex wine. The bouquet opens with crushed red berries, cherries and strawberry leaf, with a hint of candied orange peel and rosemary.

The palate is powerful and balanced, with pure flavors of strawberry, pomegranate, and notes of herbes de provence. Delicious on the palate and dry on the finish, this wine is a great match for summer fare.

Our only wish is that we could have made more.
