Doyenne 2009 Rosé

Our second vintage of the Doyenne Rosé is another success. Showing a nose of fresh strawberries, marionberries, strawberry leaf, cherry blossom and candied orange peel, this wine smells like summer in a glass.

On the palate, it expresses blackberries and earthy tones indicating the influence of Mourvèdre. The red berries and a slight note of fresh tarragon hint at the Grenache, along with a pleasant juiciness suggesting Cinsault.

The mouthfeel is silky and full-bodied, reinforcing the high quality of fruit blended to create this refreshing Rosé.

We think this is an outstanding wine to pair with all manner of foods you may enjoy during the summer months and beyond.
