2011 Four Flags A deep and concentrated Cabernet nose jumps out of the glass with black currants, cassis, fennel seed, blueberries, Herbs de Provence, toast and tar, with sweet ripe olive tapenade and plums. Muy grande power and size with tremendous fruit and iron notes. Yet with all this Red Mountain power and focus there is a seamless balance and endless finish as well. This wine has it all and will continue to get better for a long long time.

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“Even better, the 2011 Cabernet Sauvignon Four Flags is 100% Cabernet that comes from Red Mountain and is a mix from the Upchurch, Grand Ciel, Ciel du Cheval and Klipsun vineyards. Aged 20 to 22 months in French oak, it offers a full-bodied, elegant, yet classically styled profile to go with notions of cassis, black raspberry, lead pencil shavings and dried spices that show on both the nose and palate. Concentrated and rich, with excellent mid-palate density and building tannin, it nevertheless stays seamless, elegant and perfectly balanced. Give it 2-3 years in the cellar and drink it over the following 10 to 15 years.”
