DeLille Cellars 2012 Harrison Hill (*Snipes Mountain*; \$90). Intense black cherry, crushed herbs, anise, and pepper, wrapped in lush textures.

RESOLUTION #2

Collect a few good reds

Most wines aren't made to improve with age. But for the right reds, 5 to 10 years can smooth out textures and release layers of elegant flavors. Look for firm tannins, good acidity, a moderate alcohol level, and complexity. If you don't have a cellar, just store bottles on their sides in a dark, cool place.



DeLille Cellars 2012 Harrison Hill (*Snipes Mountain*; \$90). Intense black cherry, crushed herbs, anise, and pepper, wrapped in lush textures.



Spottswoode Estate 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon (*St. Helena, Napa Valley*; \$165). Deep blackberry, plum, mocha, and pepper; beautiful structure.



Stony Hill 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon (*Napa Valley*; \$60). A savory Cab, with a distinct minerality and herbal notes under vibrant black and blue fruit.



Trefethen Family 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon (*Oak Knoll District of Napa Valley*; \$60). Exotic spices, earth, and black cherry, with elegant tannins.
