DeLille Cellars 2009 Red Willow Merlot

Home to some of the oldest vines in Washington State, the vineyards at Red Willow are located on the western edge of the Yakima Valley, at relatively high elevation.

Normally reserved for D2, in 2009 several barrels of merlot were set aside for a single vineyard bottling. The nose offers enticing floral notes of dried rose petals and violets, with high-toned red fruit including cassis, raspberries, and cherries.

On the palate, the wine is accessible yet well-structured, combining pure merlot varietal notes with oak notes of vanilla, espresso, and Indian spice.
