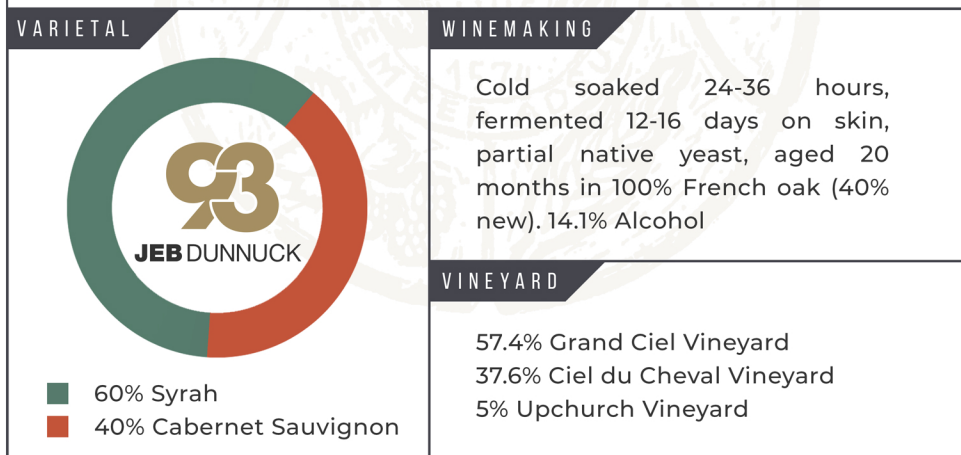

Complex, appealing, and well-integrated in its youth, supported by Red Mountain (100%) tannins and a prolonged finish, this wine should continue to impress for a decade or more.

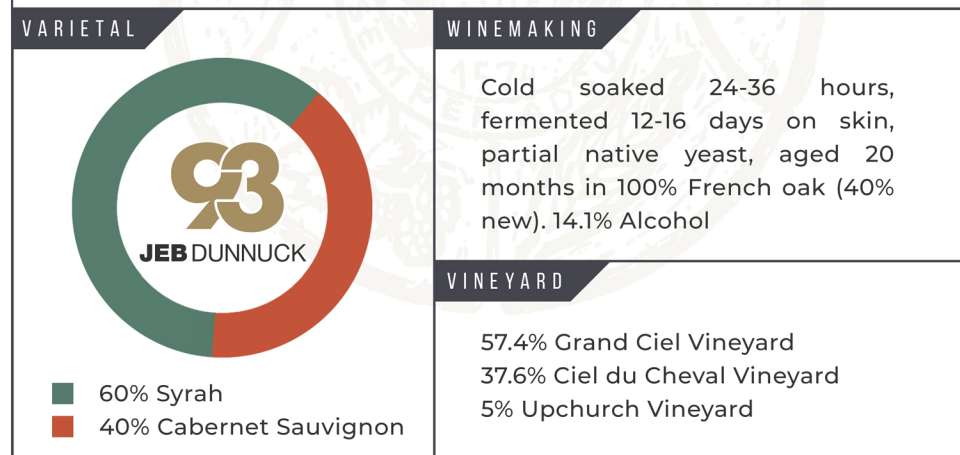
