



**2016** The 2016 vintage of Harrison Hill showcases the elegance **VINTAGE** and subtlety of the wine produced by the older vines at this Snipes Mountain site. Delicate aromas of roses, sandalwood and currant intertwine with elusive hints of orange pith and earthy truffle. Restrained on the palate, with an inviting, soft entry, flavors of red currant and anise are carried by a balanced core of bright fruit and gentle acidity. Mouth coating, supple tannin adds to the Old World complexity of this wine, allowing the flavors to linger hauntingly on the finish.
