

2 1 2 Our 2019 Chaleur Estate may be the most powerful and VINTAGE concentrated wine of the vintage for DeLille. The foundation of old vine Cabernet Sauvignon from Ciel du Cheval provides an intense, deep richness. Creme de cassis, marionberry, leather and clove meld to create the initial perfume. The Merlot from Klipsun Vineyard brings even more opulence and roundness to the blend, while adding notes of lingonberry, bay leaf and mocha. Cabernet Franc adds spice and freshness, while the Petit Verdot offers an ambrosial lift.

Cold soaked 24-36 hours, fermented 14-16 days on skin, aged 20 months in 100% French oak (100% new) and aged in bottle 8 months prior to release. 14.3% Alcohol
