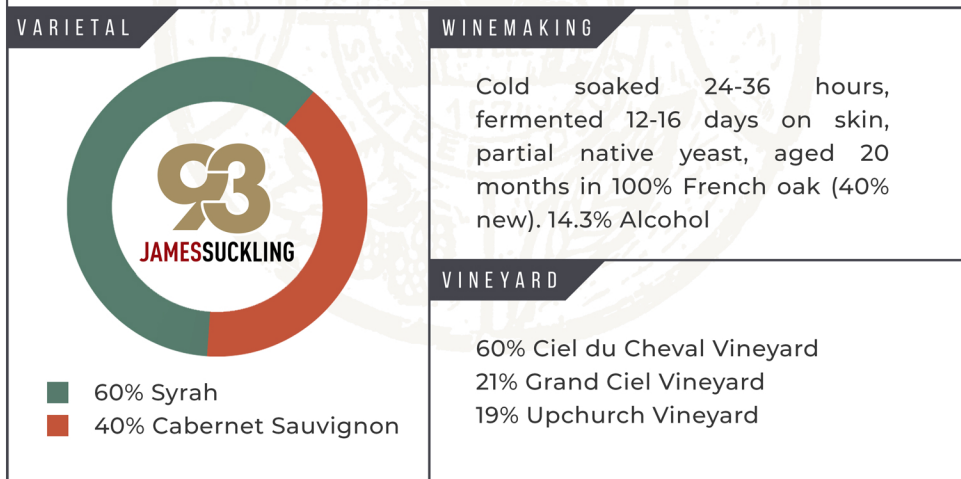




2019 In classic fashion on release of the wine, 2019 Doyenne VINTAGE presents Syrah in the forefront with Cabernet Sauvignon as the anchor. Syrah displays attractive black plum and savory smoked brisket, while capsicum, anise, and black olive tapenade are the dominant Cabernet aromas. White pepper and smokey barrel influence yield to a juicy, fruit-forward palate that remains balanced by an untamed and more rustic texture. The dense structure of this wine begs for a grilled meat companion and should allow for 8+ years of cellaring.

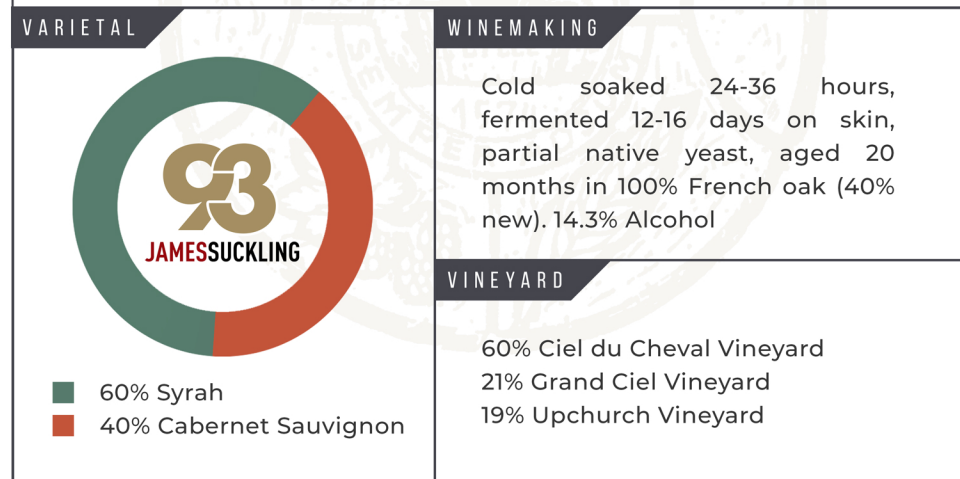
